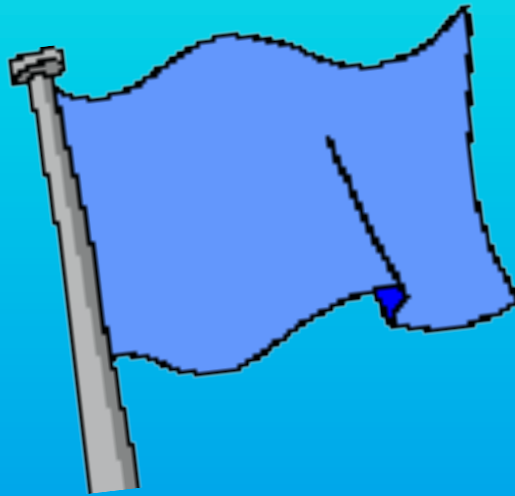


# Air Is There!

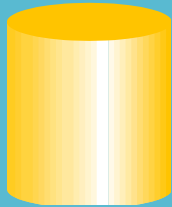
